## The Club In The Pub Motorcycle Club

### Constitution

#### **1 Name**

1. The name of the Club shall be **The Club In The Pub Motor Cycle Club**.

#### **2 Club Patch**

1. Club members displaying the Club Patch in the public eye shall conduct themselves in a manner not bringing disrepute to the club. All club patches shall remain property of **The Club In The Pub MCC**.

#### **3 Objectives**

1. The objectives of the Club are:

- To maintain a common bond / brotherhood within the club members.
- To encourage all aspects of motorcycling.
- To foster a friendly and sociable environment throughout the membership and encourage new members.
- To produce a website & forum.
- To provide an annual calendar of trips/events which is varied and fulfils the requirements of the membership and their guests?

#### **4 Rules**

1. These Rules and any part thereof may be amended at the discretion of the Club Committee. However, if a member wishes to raise a matter concerning the Rules he should do so by addressing their points to the Committee during Club Meetings. The Committee will give due consideration to the members point(s) and respond within a reasonable time limit.
2. At Club Meetings a majority of votes shall decide a resolution, the President having the casting vote in the event of even voting.
3. The committee's decision will be final.
4. A copy of the Club Rules will be sent to all new members and will be available to all members through the website.

#### **5 Responsibility of the Membership**

1. Members have a responsibility to conduct themselves so as to uphold the good reputation of the Club and promote the goodwill of the Club at all times.
2. It is the responsibility of individual members attending Club events to ensure their vehicle has valid insurance, road tax and a current M.O.T certificate.
3. A Member may be subject to Prejudicial Conduct (Para 12 refers) for:
  - Having brought the Club into disrepute; and/or
  - Having endangered the life or property of another Club Member, guest or other road user whilst on a Club event.

#### **6 Annual Subscription (Dues)**

1. The Club membership runs from 1 January until 31 December. Fees shall consist of an annual membership subscription and a single payment on joining **The Club In The Pub MCC** for the lease of the Club Patch (valid for the lifetime of the membership). New members are to purchase at least one patch on joining the Club.
2. Annual membership fees are due on 1 April each year. Any member who has not paid their dues by the end of May for that year will be deemed to have let their membership lapse. Should they wish to rejoin the Club from 1 June onwards they will be expected to pay a re-joining fee (full annual subscription).
3. The President (in consultation with the club committee) may accept or decline any application for membership.
4. Any member who gives notice to leave before the end of the subscription year will not be refunded any portion of their membership fees.
5. Any increases fees will be decided by the club committee.

#### **7 Guests**

1. Through its membership the Club encourages guests and visitors to attend events/trips/meetings. This will give prospective members a chance to enjoy the convivial and social scene before giving consideration to join. Members are responsible for their guest's conduct.

#### **8 Affiliations**

1. The Club In The Pub Motor Cycle Club has no affiliations to any other club.

#### **9 Club Officers**

1. Will consist of **President** (Chairman), **Vice President**, **Treasurer and Secretary**.
2. The Officers must be current members.
3. The President may, co-opt another member and assign that person to a temporary post for the engagement of short term specialist duties i.e. entertainments member, Webmaster etc.
4. The treasurer shall produce a summary of Club accounts at the AGM.

#### **10 Appointment of Officers**

1. The appointment of Officers shall be discussed annually during the Annual General Meeting. Should Club Officers wish to resign their posts, the appointment of new Club Officers for the coming year shall be discussed, proposed and seconded by full members of the club and elected by ballot vote.
2. In the event of a committee member absenting themselves without accepted excuse from three consecutive meetings. They shall be considered to have resigned from the committee.

#### **11 Donations to Charities**

1. The Club Committee will consult with all members concerning charity donations to worthwhile causes concentrating on local charities.

#### **12 Prejudicial Conduct**

1. Should any member contravene the rules of the Club or be considered by the club committee to have acted in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the Club or likely to bring the Club into disrepute, the President shall notify the member of the complaint and request the member respond to the complaint or, attend a meeting with the President and Club Officers. In all cases under this paragraph, the President shall consider all relevant factors and information before arriving at his decision.
2. Should no response from the member be received within 14 days the President shall withdraw membership of the member from the Club without further notice. The member will be contacted by the club committee in writing to request return of the club patch (Para 2 refers).

#### **13 Payment for Events**

1. Payments for tickets, booking fees, deposits etc are typically the responsibility of individual members. However where an individual member pays for a number of tickets or deposits in advance based on requests by club members, payments must be made as soon as tickets have been received. Failure to do so shall be considered entirely unacceptable and a contravention of Club Rules (Para 12(1) refers).
